
BLUETOOTH AND TWO MICROPHONE INPUTS OVER CATX Format-A with CATx Cable Adds XLR Mic Inputs at Ideal Locations with Wireless Bluetooth Source





Description:

One Format-A receiver is used to provide three mono line-level signals to a local mixer in the equipment rack. Bluetooth audio is sent to the receiver on pair C. Pairs A and B are used to receive line-level pre-amplified audio from each of the two Format-A microphone preamplifiers mounted in two locations in the room. Audio is connected from the Format-A senders through CATx cable with standard RJ45 connectors. The use of Format-A provides flexibility in the location of the senders, simple connection using CATx cable and the economy of a single receiver and power supply.
