
BLUETOOTH, MICROPHONE AND LINE INPUTS OVER CATX Format-A with CATx Cable Provides Both XLR Mic and User Line Inputs with Wireless Bluetooth Source





Description:

One Format-A receiver is used to provide three mono line-level signals to a local mixer in the equipment rack. Bluetooth audio is sent to the receiver on pair C. Pair B is used to receive line-level pre-amplified audio from the Format-A microphone preamplifier mounted in the wall. Pair A is used to receive mono-summed audio from a user-connected Mini-Jack or pair of RCA jacks mounted at another location in the room. Audio is connected from the Format-A senders through CATx cable with standard RJ45 connectors. The use of Format-A provides flexibility in the location of the senders, simple connection using CATx cable and the economy of a single receiver and power supply.
